UNITS DESCRIPTIONS:

International Young Women's' Ministry Coordinator: Plan and implement programs of both natural and spiritual growth and development for women 20-35 years of age. The coordinator will be expected to research the needs of young women within COOLJC and provide suggestions on how we as an auxiliary and organization can better minister to them.

International Young Men's Ministry Coordinator: Plan and implement programs of both natural and spiritual growth and development for men 20-35 years of age. The coordinator will be expected to research the needs of young men within COOLJC and provide suggestions on how we as an auxiliary and organization can better minister to them.

STRATEGIC PLAN UNITS

UNITS DESCRIPTIONS:

International Global Mission Coordinator: Serve as the International ABYPU representative to the International Global Missions Department. This individual will work closely with the International Global Missions Director to ensure that the ABYPU is kept abreast of all International Global initiatives and is expected to participate in all International Global Mission activities. This individual will also be responsible for making and keeping contact with all International Unions in COOLJC. They will work closely with the President to ensure that all information is effectively communicated to all International Unions. They will be expected to give an annual report at the general assembly of each International Union's activities as well as inform the National Union of any needs of the International Unions.

International Education Coordinator: Serve as the International ABYPU representative to the International Education Department. This individual will work closely with the International Education Director to ensure that the ABYPU is kept abreast of all International Education initiatives and is expected to participate in all International Education activities. In addition, foster professional and career development, networking and volunteer opportunities to aspiring youth in the Church of our Lord Jesus Christ, Inc through the Young Professionals Network (YPN). This person is also expected to work closely with the President, AAT Director and Kingdom Kid's Director to develop education-focused workshops and opportunities for the youth of the organization.

International Evangelism Coordinator: Serve as the International ABYPU representative to the International Evangelism Department. This individual will work closely with the International Evangelism Director to ensure that the ABYPU is kept abreast of all International Evangelism initiatives and is expected to participate in all International Evangelism activities. This person is also expected to work closely with the President, to develop evangelistic opportunities for the International Union.

STRATEGIC PLAN UNITS

UNITS DESCRIPTIONS:

International Social Media and Marketing Coordinator: The coordinator shall develop innovative and creative media content across social media platforms including Facebook, Instagram, Pinterest, Twitter and YouTube. In addition, this person will work closely with the International ABYPU Corresponding Secretary and collaborate with graphic designers and webmasters to ensure a relevant social media identity.

Let's Move: Let's Move is designed to fulfill our mission to develop healthy lifestyles amongst our young people, both spiritually and physically.

Council Of Presidents: The Council of Presidents is an advisory committee comprised of local and diocese presidents appointed by the IABYPU President, who bring unique knowledge and skills that further enhance the effectiveness of the IABYPU. The council does not have formal authority to govern the auxiliary, that is, the council cannot issue directives which must be followed. Rather, the council serves to make recommendations and provide consultation to the IABYPU President and executive team. The council plays an important constructive role in providing the executive staff with a fresh perspective on programmatic issues.

Young Professionals Network: The Young Professional Network (YPN) is a platform for young professionals provided by the International ABYPU. YPN offers networking, professional development, and volunteer opportunities to aspiring youth in the Church of our Lord Jesus Christ, Inc. The YPN connects working professionals predominately through ages 18 thru 35 and provides opportunity to network with their peers in the same field or other career paths.

Lead365: LEAD365 are practical sessions and engagements designed to speak to the leader within us all. The purpose of these sessions is to transform our thinking and foster innovation within our ministries and personal development. Whatever area of church life and ministry you find yourself in, there is something within the breadth of these sessions that will encourage and empower you in your calling and passion.
